The Identification and Recruitment (I/R) Academy will focus on the basic eligibility requirements as shared with participants of the US Department of Education Office of Migrant Education Program's Fall 2009 Conference. Identifying and recruitment of eligible migrant children is a cornerstone of the MEP. It is important to correctly identify and recruit all eligible children that are residing in our state.

The Migrant Student Information System (MSIS) Academy will provide attendees with valuable tools and tips while working with the MSIS. The latest system enhancements and the "how-to" in migrant data reporting will also be shared by Data Management staff. The MSIS Academy will be held in a computer lab setting to allow hands-on training and will also give attendees the opportunity for questions and answers.
