RE: 2009 Summer Family Eligibility Reviews

The Migrant Student Data and Recruitment office (MSDR) has the responsibility of reviewing the eligibility of migrant students served in the Title I Migrant Education Summer School Programs. The objective is accomplished by randomly selecting students enrolled in the Migrant Student Information System (MSIS) and conducting an onsite Family Eligibility Review (FER) in your district.

We would like to notify you that we may be in your district this summer to conduct FERs. Please inform the families at the time of enrollment that they might be selected to participate in a Family Eligibility Review (FER). I will notify you and your home visitor as soon as possible if I will be in your district and of the student that has been selected. If time permits, I would like to request that your home visitor arrange the interview and accompany me (bring the original COE) on the review of the family.

As time is of the essence, we ask for your assistance in ensuring MSIS enrollments are processed immediately upon student enrollment into your summer school program.
