RE: End-of-Year Data Summary Report

Enclosed is the End-of-Year Data Summary Report for School Year 2008-2009. This report includes:

- **Total Students Enrolled** - A unique count by grade level of the number of migrant students enrolled this school year.
- **Number of Students by Gender** - A summary of the unique number of males and females in each grade level.
- **Progress Towards Graduation** - A summary of the number of migrant students who are either on course to graduate, or one year or two or more years behind according to their age and grade placement. These counts are also reflected on the On-Course to Graduate Chart and On-Course to Graduate Summary.
- **Supplemental Program Data** - A summary of the unique number of migrant students served through categorical programs.
- **Students With 90% or Better Attendance** - A grade level breakdown of migrant students in your school district who had a 90% or better attendance rate, followed by a percentage of the number of students who were attending 90% of the time or more. Since information for the majority of students attending this year has been submitted on a quarterly basis, some of your attendance data might be unreported for new enrollments. However, when this report is reprinted in June for your End-of-Year Report, all of your data should be reflected in either the "Yes" or "No" columns.

Please review the enclosed report and enter any unreported data as soon as possible to ensure a complete and accurate End-of-Year Report for your district.
