RE: Identification and Recruitment of Migrant Students from California, Montana and Oregon

Our office recently received a list of students and/or Certificates of Eligibility (COEs) of students who traveled from Washington State to California, Montana and Oregon and vice versa during the 2008-2009 school year. The students listed were determined to be eligible for the Title I, Part C, Migrant Education Programs in California, Montana and Oregon.

In an effort to identify all migrant students in our state, please have your home visitor review the enclosed listing and/or COEs containing students who once resided in your district and may have returned. If the students are located and are determined to have a new qualifying move, please have your home visitor complete a new Certificate of Eligibility and have your records clerk enroll the students in the MSIS.
