The Migrant Student Data & Recruitment Office (MSDR) has the responsibility of reviewing the eligibility of migrant students served in the Title I Migrant Education School Programs. This objective is accomplished by randomly selecting students enrolled in the Migrant Student Information System (MSIS) and conducting onsite Family Eligibility Reviews (FERs) in your district.

As the regular school year has already started and home visitors are completing Certificates of Eligibility (COEs) on eligible migrant families, please inform the families that they might be selected to participate in a Family Eligibility Review this school year. We may conduct one or two reviews per home visitor. We will notify you and your home visitor of the student(s) that have been selected for review and request assistance in arranging an interview and accompanying me on a home visit with the family.
